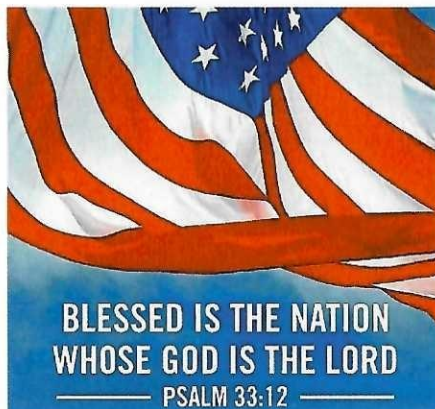

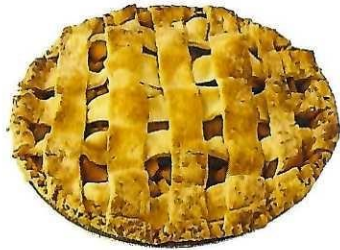

Jim Marquit Celebration of Life Saturday, July 31, 2021

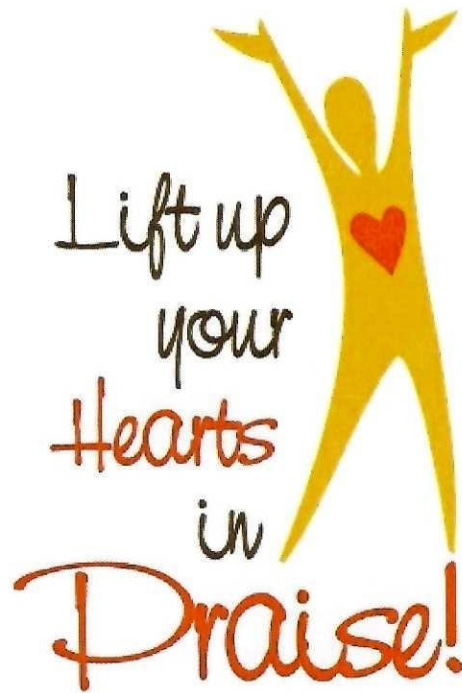


On October 24, 2020, Jim Marquit, our brother in Christ, passed from this earth into God's kingdom.
