What's your Purpose?

The prophet Isaiah, prophesied and said, "My word shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and succeed in the things for which I sent it (Isaiah 55:11).

Do you know, what is the Lord's purpose for your life? The Old Testament lesson states the purpose of the rain and the snow which is to water the earth, making the tress bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower, and bread to the eater. It does not stop until, its mission is accomplished.

SO I ask again, what is your mission? What is your purpose?

For some of us, we know exactly what our mission is, we know what God is calling us to do and we have done it. We have heard and accepted the Lord's call as did the disciples, as he said to them, come follow me. Like the disciples, we have dropped our nets, and followed him. We have rearranged our lives, so that it lines up with The Lord, we have shunned all worldly pleasures and material things, and we have armed ourselves with the word of The Lord.

They are aware of how bad their life are without God, and yet the devil has such a grip on their life. They hold on to all the things that are tearing them apart from having a relationship with God.

I remember when I was going to be confirmed, it was an exciting time, and yet a very scary time. Excited, that I am now making a bold decision to finally accept The Lord but scared that I will no longer get to do the things that my friends would do. But as I thought about it, I knew that I made the right decision because, I was not missing out on anything at all. Life without Christ is a life that is filled with corruption and pain, lawlessness and hatred and finally destruction and death. The purpose of Christ is to give us life, abundant life, life that is satisfying and filled with joy, while the devil's purpose is to kill, steal and destroy. Which will we choose?

The voice of The Lord is calling us to go out, and speak the truth of this gospel. Come to me, and find joy, come to me and find your purpose. Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost.

² Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labor on what does not satisfy? Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and you will delight in the richest of fare. ³ Give ear and come to me; listen, that you may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you.

I ask you again that if you do not yet know what your purpose is, make it your purpose to win a soul for Christ this year. Make it your mission, to identify all of the people in your life, who have

wandered far away from God, and tell them to come home, come back to The Lord. Yes, there will be resistance, yes there will be excuses, but please do not let that deter you, keep asking, keeping knocking keeping seeking, and The Lord will answer your prayers, and bring them back to him. Amen.

This year, the "Community-Wide Christmas Collaboration" in Schoharie County is in its third year of serving families with children for the Christmas holidays. The CWCC was established in 2012 to ensure that families, both young and old, receive support, care and assistance through the holidays. The Collaboration includes representatives of most of the county's non-profit organizations; Catholic Charities, Schoharie County Child Development Council (Head Start), Community Maternity Services, SALT, SCCAP and a number of churches and individuals. New to our committee this year is a representative from the CRCS schools.

The Community-Wide Christmas Collaboration has begun to plan for the 2014 holiday season. Many families within our community struggle to put food on the table, gas in the car and buy clothing for their children. We would, again this year, like to ask for the community's support in providing assistance to those who would otherwise go without. In 2012, the CWCC served 108 families; 206 children. Last year, we served 210 families; 457 children and the need is still growing. No family should have to go without this Christmas. Please help us in making this holiday season a memorable one.
